



## **BASE PILOT ASSESSMENT PROCESS SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITY**

### **Background**

The BASE rating tool has been developed by the New Zealand Green Building Council (NZGBC) and approved by Christchurch City Council as part of their vision for a sustainable Christchurch city. The Draft Christchurch Central City plan mandates a BASE certification for all CBD office and mixed use development.

An important part of the tool development process is the testing, or piloting, of the tool and the assessment process against real projects by real users. This testing provides an opportunity for building and construction professionals to become the first experts about BASE.

### **The Opportunity**

An opportunity now exists for a limited number of organisations to support the pilot process and gain considerable market advantages in terms of expertise.

As a BASE Pilot Process sponsor your organisation will nominate (no more than) two eligible staff to become the first BASE Pilot Assessors to be trained and accredited. These people will be assigned to a pilot project and given the opportunity to test the tool criteria and the process.
